### KEY FINDINGS:

- Nationally, a murderer is far more likely to be convicted than a rapist—an indication that the criminal justice system still does not take rape as seriously
- Some north-eastern states, like Mizoram, Meghalaya and Nagaland, have some of the highest per-capita incidence of rape, but also the highest conviction rates, often higher than for murder. This suggests that social norms may determine the seriousness with which rape is taken by the criminal justice system
- The overwhelming majority of perpetrators are known to victims—making clear that the main threat to women is not from strangers on the street, and possibly accounting for low reporting
